Code of Conduct

This code of conduct defines how people should act on a day-to-day basis. It reflects daily activities and operations, our core values and the overall culture of the Association.

All members are expected to observe the following rules and behaviour.

Members shall:

1. Work towards the good of both the Association and the allotment site in general, respecting and complying with the rules and regulations and the association's constitution.
2. Have due regard for the security and wellbeing of others in the allotments; this includes showing respect for other people's plots and possessions;
3. Conduct activities and communications without discrimination on the grounds of gender, sexual orientation, marital status, nationality, race, ethnic origin, religion, age or disability;
4. Never use abusive and inflammatory language, whether in person, by email, or by any other forms of communication, including social media;
5. Never make physical threats or behave in a manner intended to intimidate or bully another allotment holder or committee member;
6. Conflicts of interest should be declared and avoided if possible. Any conflicts of interest should be considered by the Committee, recorded and shared with the Members.
7. Respect the time of the Committee members who are all volunteers as well as plot holders.

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
